AN ACT

CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE AUTHORITY FOR THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE TO EXPEND AN UNUSED APPROPRIATION FOR THE LAW ENFORCEMENT GRANT PROGRAM IN THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR WITHOUT FURTHER APPROPRIATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-522, **repeal** (1)(c) as follows:

24-33.5-522. Law enforcement assistance grant program - reports. (1) (c) Any unexpended and unencumbered money from an appropriation made for the purposes of this section remains available for expenditure by the division in the next fiscal year without further appropriation.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act takes effect June 30, 2020.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
