AN ACT

CONCERNING THE PROHIBITION OF INDICATING AN ASSESSMENT SCORE ON A STUDENT'S HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-7-1016, **amend** (2) as follows:

- **22-7-1016. Assessments in high school transcripts definition.** (2) (a) Each high school student's final transcript shall MUST describe the student's level of postsecondary and workforce readiness by
- (a) indicating the student's level of performance in the postsecondary and workforce readiness program. and
- (b) (I) Indicating Notwithstanding any graduation requirement adopted by a local education provider, each high school student's transcript must not indicate the student's level of performance on the a readiness assessments assessment administered to the student pursuant to section 22-7-1006.3 in high school or on a national assessment.
- (II) For purposes of this subsection (2)(b), "national assessment" means any assessment that is administered throughout the United States to measure postsecondary or workforce readiness.

Capital letters or bold & italic numbers indicate new material added to existing law; dashes through words or numbers indicate deletions from existing law and such material is not part of the act.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
