AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A CASH FUND INTO WHICH MONEY RECEIVED FROM PHARMACEUTICAL REBATES FOR THE STATE DRUG ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT WILL BE CREDITED.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-4-1401, **amend** (2)(d) as follows:

- 25-4-1401. Drug assistance program program fund HIV medications rebate fund created legislative declaration no entitlement created. (2) (d) (I) The HIV medications rebate fund, referred to in this subsection (2)(d) as the "fund", is created in the state treasury. The fund consists of any moneys money received based on charges in excess of a federal price agreement are a donation and any additional money the general assembly appropriates to the fund. The general assembly shall continuously appropriate money in the fund to the department of public health and environment for use for the state program. Any money remaining in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year remains in the fund and shall not be credited or transferred to the general fund or any other fund.
- (II) The fund is not subject to the limit on uncommitted reserves in a cash fund established in section 24-75-402 (3).
- **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
