

1 Amend the Judiciary Committee Report, dated April 28, 2022, page 13,  
2 strike lines 36 through 42 and substitute:

3        "(a) THE FACILITY SHALL PERFORM A NON-MEDICAL EVALUATION  
4 OF THE PERSON UPON ENTRY INTO CUSTODY AT THE FACILITY FOR  
5 SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER.

6        (b) THE FACILITY SHALL OFFER MEDICATION APPROVED BY THE  
7 FEDERAL FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION THAT ARE APPROVED TO  
8 TREAT OPIATE USE DISORDER, WHICH MUST INCLUDE AGONISTS, PARTIAL  
9 AGONISTS, AND ANTAGONISTS, TO A PERSON IN CUSTODY WITH AN OPIATE  
10 USE DISORDER. THE PERSON, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE TREATING  
11 PROVIDER, MUST BE GIVEN A CHOICE CONCERNING WHAT MEDICATION IS  
12 PRESCRIBED, AND THE FACILITY MUST PROVIDE THE MEDICATION  
13 REQUESTED. A PERSON MAY REQUEST TO CHANGE THEIR MEDICATION AT  
14 ANY TIME WHILE IN CUSTODY.

15        (c) IF THE PERSON INDICATES THAT THE PERSON HAS A SUBSTANCE  
16 USE DISORDER, OR THE NON-MEDICAL EVALUATION PERFORMED PURSUANT  
17 TO SUBSECTION (1.5)(a) INDICATES THAT THE PERSON MAY HAVE A  
18 SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER, THE FACILITY SHALL REFER THE PERSON TO  
19 THE FACILITY'S MEDICAL PROVIDER FOR AN EVALUATION, AND  
20 SUBSEQUENT DIAGNOSIS, PRESCRIPTION, OR INDUCTION OF MEDICATION-  
21 ASSISTED TREATMENT.".
