2 strike lines 26 through 35 and substitute:

6 PARTICIPATE IN THE WEB-BASED OVERDOSE DETECTION MAPPING
7 APPLICATION PROGRAM TO REPORT INCIDENCES OF FATAL AND NON-FATAL
8 DRUG OVERDOSES AND SYNTHETIC OPIATE POISONINGS. EMERGENCY
9 DEPARTMENTS, STATE AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES,
10 SHERIFFS' OFFICES, AND CORONERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO REPORT DATA
11 NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS AFTER THE INCIDENT OR AFTER
12 RECEIVING THE INCIDENT TOXICOLOGY REPORT. ALL INCIDENT DATA MUST
13 BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LAW
14 TO THE CONTRARY, LAW ENFORCEMENT SHALL NOT USE DATA FROM THE
15 OVERDOSE DETECTION MAPPING APPLICATION PROGRAM FOR WELFARE
16 CHECKS, WARRANT CHECKS, OR CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS.".

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
