

1 Amend the Judiciary Committee Report, dated April 28, 2022, page 15,  
2 strike lines 26 through 35 and substitute:

3 **"program.** ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2023, EMERGENCY MEDICAL  
4 SERVICE PROVIDERS, EMERGENCY DEPARTMENTS, STATE AND LOCAL LAW  
5 ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES, SHERIFFS' OFFICES, AND CORONERS SHALL  
6 PARTICIPATE IN THE WEB-BASED OVERDOSE DETECTION MAPPING  
7 APPLICATION PROGRAM TO REPORT INCIDENCES OF FATAL AND NON-FATAL  
8 DRUG OVERDOSES AND SYNTHETIC OPIATE POISONINGS. DATA MUST BE  
9 REPORTED NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS AFTER THE INCIDENT OR  
10 AFTER RECEIVING THE INCIDENT TOXICOLOGY REPORT. ALL INCIDENT  
11 DATA MUST BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT.  
12 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LAW TO THE CONTRARY, LAW ENFORCEMENT  
13 SHALL NOT USE DATA FROM THE OVERDOSE DETECTION MAPPING  
14 APPLICATION PROGRAM FOR WELFARE CHECKS, WARRANT CHECKS, OR  
15 CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS.".

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
