

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Appropriations.

HB22-1326 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 60, line 15, strike "\$4,033,875" and  
2 substitute "\$14,286,838".

3 Page 60, line 17, strike "\$883,875" and substitute "\$10,883,875" and  
4 strike "\$150,000" and substitute "\$402,963".

5 Page 61, before line 1 insert:

6 "(b) \$10,000,000 from the general fund for treatment and  
7 detoxification programs related to substance use treatment and prevention  
8 services pursuant to section 27-80-107.8 (2), C.R.S.;"

9 Page 61, line 1, strike "(b)" and substitute "(c)".

10 Page 61, after line 3 insert:

11 "(d) \$252,963 from the correctional treatment cash fund created  
12 in section 18-19-103 (4)(a), C.R.S., for a study on the health effects of  
13 criminal penalties related to substance use treatment and prevention  
14 services, which amount is based on an assumption that the administration  
15 will require an additional 0.5 FTE;"

16 Page 61, line 4, strike "(c)" and substitute "(e)".

17 Page 61, line 7, strike "(d)" and substitute "(f)".

18 Page 61, after line 12 insert:

19 "(2) Pursuant to section 27-80-107.8 (2)(b), C.R.S., any money  
20 appropriated in subsection (1)(b) not expended prior to July 1, 2023, is  
21 further appropriated to the division through June 30, 2025, for the same  
22 purpose."

23 Page 61, line 13, strike "(2)" and substitute "(3)".

24 Page 61, after line 22 insert:

25 "(4) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$150,000 is appropriated to  
26 the department of law for use by administration. This appropriation is  
27 from the general fund. To implement this act, the department may use this  
28 appropriation for operating expenses."

29 Page 61, strike lines 23 through 27 and substitute

30 "(5) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$5,792,413 is appropriated  
31 to the department of public health and environment for use by the

1 prevention services division. This appropriation is from the general fund.  
2 To implement this act, the division may use this appropriation for  
3 administration as follows:  
4 (a) \$112,413 for personal services and related operating expenses,  
5 which amount is based on an assumption that the division will require an  
6 additional 1.5 FTE;  
7 (b) \$300,000 for non-laboratory synthetic opiate detection tests  
8 pursuant to section 25-1.5-115.3 (1), C.R.S.;  
9 (c) \$5,000,000 for an education campaign pursuant to section 25-  
10 1.5-115.5 (1), C.R.S.;  
11 (d) \$50,000 for regional trainings pursuant to section 25-1.5-115.5  
12 (3), C.R.S.;  
13 (e) \$30,000 for website development pursuant to section 25-  
14 25-1.5-115.5 (4), C.R.S.; and  
15 (f) \$300,000 for an independent study pursuant to section 25-20.5-  
16 1401, C.R.S.  
17 (6) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$7,000,000 is appropriated to  
18 the department of public safety for use by the division of criminal justice.  
19 This appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an assumption  
20 that the division will require an additional 1.8 FTE. To implement this  
21 act, the division may use this appropriation for DCJ administrative  
22 services. Any money appropriated in this subsection (8) not expended  
23 prior to July 1, 2023, is further appropriated to the division for the 2023-  
24 state fiscal year."

25 Page 62, strike line 1.

26 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly.

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
