3 "Amend printed bill, page 3, strike lines 5 through 27 and substitute:

4 **"13-14.5-101. Short title.** THE SHORT TITLE OF THIS ARTICLE 14.5
5 IS THE "CHILD SAFETY ACCOUNT ACT".

6 **13-14.5-102. Definitions.** AS USED IN THIS ARTICLE 14.5, UNLESS
7 THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE CLEARLY REQUIRES:

8 (1) "EXTREME RISK" MEANS FORCING A STUDENT TO REMAIN IN A
9 SCHOOL WHO WAS INVOLVED IN A "SAFETY INCIDENT", AS DEFINED BY
10 HOUSE BILL 19-1112, ENACTED IN 2019.

11 (2) "PROTECTION ORDERS" MEANS A SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY THAT
12 ALLOWS FOR STUDENTS TO USE "CHILD SAFETY ACCOUNTS" AS DEFINED BY
13 HOUSE BILL 19-1112, ENACTED IN 2019, TO MOVE TO ANOTHER SCHOOL,
14 WHICH WOULD BE FUNDED ANNUALLY BY APPROPRIATION.

15 **13-14.5-103. Extreme risk protection orders.** EACH SCHOOL
16 DISTRICT IN COLORADO SHALL ADOPT PROTECTION ORDERS THAT PROHIBIT
17 EXTREME RISK.".

19 Page 30, strike lines 1 through 15.

20 Rerumber succeeding section accordingly.".
