## HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

BY REPRESENTATIVE Richardson

1 Amend printed bill, page 9, line 1, strike "Program" and substitute  
 2 "~~Program~~ PROGRAM<sup>9a</sup>".

3 Page 9, line 2, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike "359,096,944"  
 4 and substitute "358,096,944" and in the CASH FUNDS column strike  
 5 "212,763,744" and substitute "211,763,744".

6 Page 9, line 4, strike "Program" and substitute "~~Program~~ PROGRAM<sup>9a</sup>".

7 Adjust affected totals accordingly.

8 Page 16, after line 15 insert:

9       "9a DEPARTMENT OF EARLY CHILDHOOD, EARLY  
 10 LEARNING ACCESS AND QUALITY, UNIVERSAL  
 11 PRESCHOOL PROGRAM; CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE  
 12 PROGRAM -- THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT  
 13 MAXIMIZING COORDINATION BETWEEN UPK AND  
 14 CCCAP THROUGH FUND STACKING IS ESSENTIAL TO  
 15 SERVING THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ELIGIBLE  
 16 FAMILIES WITHIN AVAILABLE APPROPRIATIONS. THE  
 17 DEPARTMENT SHOULD PRIORITIZE TECHNICAL  
 18 ASSISTANCE TO COUNTIES AND PROVIDERS TO  
 19 FACILITATE DUAL ENROLLMENT AND ACCURATE  
 20 BILLING PRACTICES."

**PURPOSE:** Reduces by \$1.0 million cash funds for the Universal Preschool Program in the Department of **Early Childhood**. Adds a footnote specifying legislative intent for the Department of **Early Childhood** to prioritize technical assistance for fund stacking between the Universal Preschool Program and the Colorado Child Care Assistance Program.
