- 22 Page 67, before line 1 insert:
- 23 **"SECTION 2. Appropriation.** Notwithstanding any other  
24 provision of this act, appropriations in section 1 of this act from the  
25 general fund for the department of public health and environment are  
26 reduced by \$3,837,627, under the assumption that this reduction be  
27 applied proportionally to the department's personal services and program

- 1 costs. This does not include personal services or program costs within the
- 2 water quality control division and the division of disease control and
- 3 public health response.".
- 4 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

**PURPOSE:** Removes \$3,837,627 in General Fund reductions for health disparities grants and local public health funding in the Department of **Public Health and Environment**. Reduces administrative costs across the Department by an equal amount, except within the Water Quality Control Division and the Division of Disease Control and Public Health Response.
