

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on State, Veterans, & Military Affairs.

SB26-106 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 4, strike line 27.

2 Page 5, line 5, after the period add "THE TIMING AND DEADLINES THAT
3 THE SECRETARY OF STATE ESTABLISHES PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION
4 (2)(e) MUST OCCUR PRIOR TO MAIL BALLOT PACKET PRODUCTION
5 FINALIZATION.

6 (f) A PROCESS BY WHICH A COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER MUST
7 PROVIDE ANY NOTICE THAT IS LEGALLY REQUIRED TO BE DELIVERED
8 WITHIN THE MAIL BALLOT PACKET TO A REGISTERED ELECTOR WHO HAS
9 CHOSEN NOT TO RECEIVE A MAIL BALLOT PACKET FOR ALL ELECTIONS
10 THAT THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER CONDUCTS BY MAIL PURSUANT
11 TO THIS ARTICLE 7.5."

12 Page 5, after line 15 insert:

13 "(5) IF A REGISTERED ELECTOR HAS CHOSEN NOT TO RECEIVE A
14 MAIL BALLOT PACKET FOR ALL ELECTIONS THAT THE COUNTY CLERK AND
15 RECORDER CONDUCTS BY MAIL PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE 7.5, THE
16 COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER SHALL ENSURE THAT ANY NOTICE THAT IS
17 LEGALLY REQUIRED TO BE DELIVERED WITHIN THE MAIL BALLOT PACKET
18 IS PROVIDED TO THE ELECTOR THROUGH AN ALTERNATIVE METHOD
19 PRESCRIBED BY RULE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

20 (6) A COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER IS NOT LIABLE FOR FAILURE
21 TO MAIL A MAIL BALLOT PACKET TO A REGISTERED ELECTOR IF THE CLERK
22 AND RECORDER REASONABLY RELIED ON THE DURABLE INDICATOR
23 CONTAINED IN THE STATEWIDE VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM PURSUANT
24 TO SUBSECTION (2)(c) OF THIS SECTION, THAT A REGISTERED ELECTOR HAS
25 CHOSEN NOT TO RECEIVE A MAIL BALLOT PACKET FOR ALL ELECTIONS
26 THAT THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER CONDUCTS BY MAIL.

27 (7) A REGISTERED ELECTOR'S DECISION NOT TO RECEIVE A MAIL
28 BALLOT PACKET FOR ALL ELECTIONS THAT THE COUNTY CLERK AND
29 RECORDER CONDUCTS BY MAIL PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE 7.5 DOES NOT
30 IMPACT THE REGISTERED ELECTOR'S REGISTRATION STATUS OR ACTIVE
31 STATUS FOR PURPOSES OF THIS CODE."

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
