HB26-1271 be amended as follows:

1 Amend proposed committee amendment (HB1271_L.004), page 1, line
2 10, strike "COMMUNITIES." and substitute "COMMUNITIES.

3 (e) THE BEER, CIDER, AND APPLE WINE IMPACT AND RECOVERY
4 ENTERPRISE SHALL PRIORITIZE FUNDING FOR JAIL-BASED TREATMENT
5 SERVICES ADDRESSING ALCOHOL USE DISORDER. PROGRAMS AND SERVICES
6 FUNDED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (1)(d)(II) MUST BE DELIVERED BY
7 QUALIFIED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROVIDERS, COMMUNITY-BASED
8 ORGANIZATIONS, OR PEER SUPPORT PROFESSIONALS, AND MAY BE
9 PROVIDED IN JAILS IN COORDINATION WITH JAIL ADMINISTRATORS.

10 (f) IN MAKING FUNDING DETERMINATIONS, THE BEER, CIDER, AND
11 APPLE WINE IMPACT AND RECOVERY ENTERPRISE SHALL CONSIDER THE
12 NEEDS OF TRIBAL COMMUNITIES AND THE NEEDS FOR JAIL-BASED
13 TREATMENT SERVICES ADDRESSING ALCOHOL USE DISORDER."

17 ALCOHOL USE DISORDER. PROGRAMS AND SERVICES FUNDED PURSUANT TO
18 THIS SUBSECTION (1)(d)(II) MUST BE DELIVERED BY QUALIFIED
19 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROVIDERS, COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS,
20 OR PEER SUPPORT PROFESSIONALS, AND MAY BE PROVIDED IN JAILS IN
21 COORDINATION WITH JAIL ADMINISTRATORS.
