HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT  
Committee on Transportation, Housing & Local Government.  
HB26-1286 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 12, strike "**definitions.**" and substitute  
2 "**definitions - repeal.**".

3 Page 3, lines 3 and 4, strike "TO THE PENALTIES SET FORTH IN SECTION  
4 42-4-1701 (4)(a)(I)(A) AND (4)(g)." and substitute "TO:

5 (a) A PENALTY OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND A SURCHARGE OF  
6 ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS FOR A FIRST CONVICTION;

7 (b) A PENALTY OF TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS AND A SURCHARGE OF  
8 ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS FOR A SECOND CONVICTION; OR

9 (c) (I) A SURCHARGE OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS; AND

10 (II) A PENALTY THAT DOUBLES THE PENALTY DESCRIBED IN  
11 SUBSECTION (3)(b) OF THIS SECTION FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT CONVICTION  
12 AFTER THE SECOND CONVICTION."

13 Page 3, after line 15 insert:

14 "(6) (a) THIS SECTION IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1,  
15 2031.

16 (b) THE CHIEF OF THE COLORADO STATE PATROL SHALL ANALYZE  
17 THIS SECTION'S EFFECTS ON COMMERCIAL VEHICLE SAFETY ON HIGHWAYS.  
18 BY NOVEMBER 1, 2030, THE CHIEF OF THE COLORADO STATE PATROL  
19 SHALL, BASED ON THE REVIEW, ISSUE A REPORT TO THE HOUSE OF  
20 REPRESENTATIVES TRANSPORTATION, HOUSING, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT  
21 COMMITTEE AND THE SENATE TRANSPORTATION AND ENERGY COMMITTEE,  
22 OR THEIR SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES. THE REPORT MUST MAKE  
23 RECOMMENDATIONS AS WHETHER TO CONTINUE THIS SECTION, AND, IF THE  
24 RECOMMENDATION IS TO CONTINUE THIS SECTION, ANY RECOMMENDED  
25 LEGISLATION TO IMPROVE THIS SECTION."

26 Page 3, strike lines 16 through 27.

27 Strike page 4.

28 Page 5, strike lines 1 through 4.

29 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
