HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Health & Human Services.

SB26-113 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 7, strike lines 14 through 17 and substitute:

2 "(b) A RECOVERY RESIDENCE SHALL NOT CATEGORICALLY
3 PROHIBIT A RECOVERY RESIDENT'S ABILITY TO TAKE PRESCRIBED
4 MEDICATIONS, INCLUDING CONTROLLED MEDICATIONS, IN ACCORDANCE
5 WITH A PHYSICIAN'S ORDERS. ADMISSION TO, OR CONTINUED RESIDENCE
6 IN, A RECOVERY RESIDENCE MUST NOT BE CONTINGENT UPON THE
7 CESSATION OF TAKING PRESCRIBED MEDICATIONS UNLESS THE RECOVERY
8 RESIDENCE DETERMINES, THROUGH AN INDIVIDUALIZED ASSESSMENT,
9 THAT THE RECOVERY RESIDENT'S USE OF THE MEDICATION POSES A RISK TO
10 THE SAFETY OF THE RECOVERY RESIDENTS, OR TO THE RECOVERY
11 ENVIRONMENT, AND THAT THE RISK CANNOT BE MITIGATED BY
12 REASONABLE ACCOMMODATION. IN MAKING AN INDIVIDUALIZED
13 DETERMINATION, THE RECOVERY RESIDENCE SHALL CONSIDER INDIVIDUAL
14 FACTORS FOR THE RECOVERY RESIDENT WHO IS PRESCRIBED THE
15 MEDICATION THAT MAY MITIGATE OR INCREASE RISK OF MISUSE OR
16 DIVERSION OF THE PRESCRIBED MEDICATION. THE RECOVERY RESIDENCE
17 SHALL ESTABLISH POLICIES AND PROCEDURES TO IMPLEMENT THIS
18 SUBSECTION (6)(b).".

19 Page 7, line 19, strike "STAFF".
