

SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 3, strike lines 17 through 22.
- 2 Page 3, line 27, strike "STATUS, SHALL NOT RECEIVE," and substitute
3 "STATUS:
4 (I) SHALL NOT RECEIVE,".
- 5 Page 4, line 8, strike "2026." and substitute "2026;".
- 6 Page 4, after line 8 insert:
7 "(II) ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR SERVICES OFFERED THROUGH THE
8 ACCOUNTABLE CARE COLLABORATIVE PURSUANT TO SECTION 25.5-5-419;
9 (III) SHALL NOT RECEIVE MANAGED CARE SERVICES PURSUANT TO
10 PART 4 OF ARTICLE 5 OF THIS TITLE 25.5; AND
11 (IV) MUST BE OFFERED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES ON A
12 FEE-FOR-SERVICE BASIS ONLY.".
- 13 Page 23, before line 1 insert:
14 **"SECTION 15. Appropriation - adjustments to 2026 long bill.**
15 (1) For the 2026-27 state fiscal year, \$271,952 is appropriated to
16 the department of health care policy and financing. This appropriation is
17 from the general fund, which amount is subject to the "(M)" notation as
18 defined in the annual general appropriation act for the same fiscal year.
19 To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation for
20 medical and long-term care services for Medicaid-eligible individuals.
21 (2) For the 2026-27 state fiscal year, the general assembly
22 anticipates that the department of health care policy and financing will
23 receive \$505,051 in federal funds to implement this act. The
24 appropriation in subsection (1) of this section is based on the assumption
25 that the department will receive this amount of federal funds to be used
26 for medical and long-term care services for Medicaid-eligible individuals.
27 (3) To implement this act, the appropriations made in the annual
28 general appropriation act from the general fund for the 2026-27 state
29 fiscal year to the department of health care policy and financing for
30 general professional services and special projects are decreased by
31 \$271,952.".
- 32 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 33 Page 23, line 21, strike "and".
- 34 Page 23, line 24, strike "later." and substitute "later; and

1 (7) Section 15 of this act takes effect only if the annual general
2 appropriation act for the 2026-27 state fiscal year becomes law, in which
3 case section 15 takes effect upon the effective date of this act or of the
4 annual general appropriation act for state fiscal year 2026-27, whichever
5 is later."

7 Strike "act," and substitute "act;" on: **Page 23**, lines 10 and 16.
