1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 9, after line 26 insert:

2 "SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-17-507, amend
3 (1)(b) and (2) as follows:

4 **25-17-507. Enforcement - possible penalties.**

5 (1) (b) ~~(f)~~ A county that chooses to enforce a violation of this part
6 5 against a store or retail food establishment located within the
7 unincorporated boundaries of the county may seek injunctive relief
8 against the store or retail food establishment or may assess ~~the following~~
9 ~~civil penalties against the store or retail food establishment.~~ A CIVIL
10 PENALTY AGAINST THE STORE OR RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENT OF UP TO
11 FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR A FOURTH OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION.

12 ~~(A) Up to five hundred dollars for a second violation; or~~

13 ~~(B) Up to one thousand dollars for a third or subsequent violation.~~

14 ~~(H) A county that chooses to enforce a violation of this part 5 may~~
15 ~~both seek injunctive relief and impose a civil penalty in accordance with~~
16 ~~this subsection (1)(b).~~

17 (2) For purposes of this section, ~~each retail sales transaction in~~
18 ~~which a violation of this part 5 is committed, regardless of whether~~
19 ~~multiple violations of this part 5 are committed in one retail sales~~
20 ~~transaction, constitutes a single violation of this part 5~~ VIOLATIONS OF
21 THIS PART 5 THAT OCCUR WITHIN THE SAME CALENDAR MONTH ARE NOT
22 CONSIDERED MULTIPLE VIOLATIONS."
