Second Reading

1 Amend the Judiciary Committee Report, dated March 19, 2024, Page 2,
2 of the report, strike lines 1 through 3 and substitute:

3 "Page 15 of the bill, strike line 27.

4 Page 16 of the bill, strike lines 1 though 7 and substitute:

5 "(3)(a) AN INDIVIDUAL OR ENTITY THAT DOES NOT HAVE A PERMIT
6 TO SELL FIREARMS BUT SELLS OR ATTEMPTS TO MAKE A PRIVATE SALE OF
7 A RAPID-FIRE TRIGGER ACTIVATOR IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (1) OF
8 THIS SECTION ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2025, SHALL BE ASSESSED A CIVIL
9 PENALTY IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS.

10 (b) A LICENSED GUN DEALER, LICENSED FIREARMS DEALER, GUN
11 SHOW VENDOR, OR OTHER PERSON THAT HAS A PERMIT TO SELL FIREARMS
12 WHO SELLS OR ATTEMPTS TO SELL A RAPID-FIRE TRIGGER ACTIVATOR IN
13 VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION ON OR AFTER JULY 1,
14 2025, SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE. THE
15 DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SHALL TAKE ACTIONS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

16 (c) A LICENSED GUN DEALER, LICENSED FIREARMS DEALER, GUN
17 SHOW VENDOR, OR OTHER PERSON THAT HAS A PERMIT TO SELL FIREARMS
18 THAT PURCHASES A RAPID-FIRE TRIGGER ACTIVATOR FROM A
19 MANUFACTURER OF RAPID-FIRE TRIGGER ACTIVATORS THAT OPERATES IN
20 COLORADO SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE. THE
21 DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SHALL ACTIONS
22 AS REQUIRED BY LAW."."

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
