

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Appropriations.

SB22-138 be amended as follows:

1 Amend the Transportation and Energy Committee Report, dated March
2 15, 2022, page 6, strike lines 8 through 12 and lines 26 and 27.

3 Amend printed bill, page 13, before line 12 insert:

4 **"SECTION 12. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal
5 year, \$81,429 is appropriated to the department of natural resources for
6 use by the oil and gas conservation commission. This appropriation is
7 from the oil and gas conservation and environmental response fund
8 created in section 34-60-122 (5)(a), C.R.S., and is based on an assumption
9 that the commission will require an additional 0.8 FTE. To implement this
10 act, the commission may use this appropriation for the underground
11 injection program.

12 (2) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$145,789 is appropriated to
13 the department of public health and environment for use by the air
14 pollution control division. This appropriation is from the general fund. To
15 implement this act, the subdivision may use this appropriation as follows:

16 (a) \$131,094 for personal services related to stationary sources,
17 which amount is based on an assumption that the division will require an
18 additional 1.5 FTE; and

19 (b) \$14,695 for operating expenses related to stationary sources.

20 (3) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$2,098,784 is appropriated
21 to the department of agriculture for use by the agricultural services
22 division. This appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an
23 assumption that the division will require an additional 0.8 FTE. To
24 implement this act, the division may use this appropriation for
25 conservation services."

26 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

27 Page 1, line 102, strike "**COLORADO.**" and substitute "**COLORADO, AND,**
28 **IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**".
