HOUSE BILL 22-1135

CONCERNING PERMITTING THE TRANSFER OF A MARIJUANA TRANSPORTER LICENSE WITH A CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-10-505, **amend** (1)(a) as follows:

44-10-505. Medical marijuana transporter license - definition.

(1) (a) A medical marijuana transporter license may be issued to a person to provide logistics, distribution, delivery, and storage of medical marijuana and medical marijuana products. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, a medical marijuana transporter license is valid for two years. ~~but cannot be transferred with a change of ownership.~~ A licensed medical marijuana transporter is responsible for the medical marijuana and medical marijuana products once it takes control of the product.

Capital letters or bold & italic numbers indicate new material added to existing law; dashes through words or numbers indicate deletions from existing law and such material is not part of the act.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-10-605, **amend** (1)(a) as follows:

44-10-605. Retail marijuana transporter license - definition.

(1) (a) A retail marijuana transporter license may be issued to a person to provide logistics, distribution, delivery, and storage of retail marijuana and retail marijuana products. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, a retail marijuana transporter license is valid for two years. ~~but cannot be transferred with a change of ownership.~~ A licensed retail marijuana transporter is responsible for the retail marijuana and retail marijuana products once it takes control of the product.

SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in

November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
