A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF PREPRODUCTION**
102 **PLASTIC MATERIALS.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill prohibits the discharge of plastic pellets and other preproduction plastic materials through land application or into state waters, wastewater, storm water runoff, or other runoff by a facility, point source, or person that makes, uses, handles, packages, or transports plastic pellets or other preproduction plastic materials in the state.

Capital letters or bold & italic numbers indicate new material to be added to existing law.
Dashes through the words or numbers indicate deletions from existing law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** part 11 to article 8 of title 25 as follows:

PART 11

PLASTIC PELLET-FREE WATERS ACT

25-8-1101. Short title.

THE SHORT TITLE OF THIS PART 11 IS THE "PLASTIC PELLET-FREE WATERS ACT".

25-8-1102. Definitions.

AS USED IN THIS PART 11, UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE
REQUIRES:

12 (1) "DISCHARGE" MEANS THE INTRODUCTION OR ADDITION OF A
13 POLLUTANT INTO STATE WATERS, WASTEWATER, STORM WATER RUNOFF,
14 OR OTHER RUNOFF.

15 (2) (a) "FACILITY" MEANS A FACILITY THAT MAKES, USES,
16 PACKAGES, OR TRANSPORTS PLASTIC PELLETS OR OTHER PREPRODUCTION
17 PLASTIC MATERIALS IN THE STATE.

18 (b) "FACILITY" DOES NOT INCLUDE A TREATMENT WORKS, AS
19 DEFINED IN SECTION 212 OF THE FEDERAL ACT.

20 (3) (a) "PREPRODUCTION PLASTIC MATERIALS" MEANS
21 PREPRODUCTION PLASTIC PELLETS, FLAKES, FIBERS, POWDERS, OR
22 POWDERED COLORING FOR PLASTICS, IN THEIR RAW OR PRIMARY STATE

23 (b) "PREPRODUCTION PLASTIC MATERIALS" DOES NOT INCLUDE
24 MATERIALS RESULTING FROM THE BREAKDOWN OF MANUFACTURED OR
25 OTHERWISE USEFUL PLASTIC PRODUCTS

25-8-1103 Discharge of preproduction plastic materials

1 **prohibited.**

2 A FACILITY SHALL NOT DISCHARGE PLASTIC PELLETS OR OTHER
3 PREPRODUCTION PLASTIC MATERIALS IN THE STATE.

4 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-8-501, **add** (7) as
5 follows:

6 **25-8-501. Permits required for discharge of pollutants -**
7 **administration.**

8 (7) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION, THE
9 DIVISION SHALL NOT ISSUE A PERMIT FOR THE DISCHARGE OF PLASTIC
10 PELLETS OR OTHER PREPRODUCTION PLASTIC MATERIALS INTO STATE
11 WATERS.

12 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-8-609, **amend** (1)
13 as follows:

14 **25-8-609. Criminal pollution - penalties.**

15 (1) ~~Any~~ A person ~~who~~ THAT recklessly, knowingly, intentionally,
16 or with criminal negligence discharges ~~any~~ A pollutant into any state
17 waters or into any domestic wastewater treatment works commits
18 criminal pollution if such discharge is made:

19 (a) In violation of ~~any~~ A permit issued under this ~~article~~, or
20 ARTICLE 8;

21 (b) In violation of ~~any~~ A cease-and-desist order or clean-up order
22 issued by the division ~~which~~ THAT is final and not stayed by court order;
23 or

24 (c) Without a permit, if a permit is required by ~~the provisions of~~
25 this ~~article~~ ARTICLE 8 for such discharge; or

26 (d) ~~Repeated.~~

27 (e) (d) In violation of any pretreatment regulations ~~promulgated~~

1 ADOPTED by the commission; OR

2 (e) IN VIOLATION OF THE PROHIBITION ON THE DISCHARGE OF
3 PREREPRODUCTION PLASTIC MATERIALS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 25-8-1103.

4 **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 25-15-329 as
5 follows:

6 **25-15-329. Discharge of preproduction plastic materials**
7 **prohibited - definitions.**

8 (1) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE
9 REQUIRES:

10 (a) "DISCHARGE" MEANS THE INTRODUCTION OR ADDITION OF A
11 POLLUTANT THROUGH LAND APPLICATION AT A LOCATION THAT DOES NOT
12 HAVE FEDERAL INTERIM STATUS, A FEDERAL PERMIT GRANTED PURSUANT
13 TO THE FEDERAL ACT, OR A STATE PERMIT GRANTED BY THE DEPARTMENT
14 PURSUANT TO SECTION 25-15-303.

15 (b) (I) "FACILITY" MEANS A FACILITY THAT MAKES, USES,
16 PACKAGES, OR TRANSPORTS PLASTIC PELLETS OR OTHER PREREPRODUCTION
17 PLASTIC MATERIALS IN THE STATE.

18 (II) "FACILITY" DOES NOT INCLUDE A TREATMENT WORKS, AS
19 DEFINED IN SECTION 212 OF THE FEDERAL "CLEAN WATER ACT", 33
20 U.S.C. SEC. 1251 ET SEQ.

21 (c) "LAND APPLICATION" MEANS A DISCHARGE BEING APPLIED TO
22 THE LAND.

23 (d) "PREREPRODUCTION PLASTIC MATERIALS" HAS THE MEANING SET
24 FORTH IN SECTION 25-8-1102.

25 (2) A FACILITY SHALL NOT DISCHARGE PLASTIC PELLETS OR OTHER
26 PREREPRODUCTION PLASTIC MATERIALS IN THE STATE.

27 **SECTION 5. Act subject to petition - effective date -**

1 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect August 12, 2027; except that, if
2 a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
3 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
4 within the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general
5 assembly, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless
6 approved by the people at the general election to be held in November
7 2026 and, in such case, will take effect August 12, 2027.

8 (2) This act applies to conduct occurring on or after the applicable
9 effective date of this act.
