HOUSE BILL 26-1172

CONCERNING FUNDING FOR CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION, AND MAKING
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Capital construction appropriations for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022. In Session Laws of Colorado 2022, section 3 of chapter 507, (HB 22-1329), **amend** Part II (1)(B), Part III (2)(B), and the affected totals, as the affected totals are amended by section 1 of chapter 473, (SB 23-135), Session Laws of Colorado 2023; as the Part III affected totals are amended by section 2 of chapter 517, (HB 24-1203), as the Part II affected totals are amended by section 32 of chapter 257, (HB 24-1465), and as Part II (1)(B) and Part III (2)(B) are amended by section 82 of chapter 429, (HB 24-1466), Session Laws of Colorado 2024; as Part III and the affected totals are further amended by, section 3 of chapter 474, (SB 25-111), and as Part II and Part III are further amended by section 36 of chapter 301, (SB 25-312), Session Laws of Colorado 2025; and **add** footnote 112a as follows:
