**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101 **CONCERNING ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE COMMISSION**  
102 **ON JUDICIAL DISCIPLINE SPECIAL CASH FUND BEGIN EACH STATE**  
103 **FISCAL YEAR WITH A BALANCE OF AT LEAST FOUR HUNDRED**

**Joint Budget Committee.** The bill eliminates the requirement that the general assembly transfer sufficient funds to the commission on judicial discipline special cash fund (fund) so that the fund starts each

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 13-5.3-104, **repeal**  
3 (7); and **add** (8) as follows:

4           **13-5.3-104. Commission on judicial discipline special cash**  
5 **fund - acceptance of federal funds - general appropriations - repeal.**

6           ~~(7) For the state fiscal year 2022-23, the general assembly shall~~  
7 ~~appropriate from the general fund to the fund four hundred thousand~~  
8 ~~dollars. In each subsequent fiscal year, the general assembly shall~~  
9 ~~appropriate sufficient money to the fund so that it begins the fiscal year~~  
10 ~~with not less than four hundred thousand dollars.~~

11           (8) (a) ON JUNE 30, 2026, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER  
12 FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE FUND TO THE GENERAL  
13 FUND.

14           (b) THIS SUBSECTION (8) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2027.

15           **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,  
16 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
17 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for  
18 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state  
19 institutions.
