**Fiscal Note Status**

---

The most recent Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note (attached) reflects the fiscal impact of the bill as of 03/18/2026.

**Update:** Fiscal impact has changed due to technical issues.

The fiscal note indicates that the Parks and Outdoor Recreation Cash Fund and the Wildlife Cash Fund are continuously appropriated. However, both of these cash funds are subject to annual appropriations. Therefore, the bill requires an appropriations clause. Legislative Council Staff and JBC Staff agree with this correction.

Staff amendment **J.001** (attached) appropriates a total of \$120,000 to the Department of Natural Resources for FY 2026-27, including \$90,000 from the Parks and Outdoor Recreation Cash Fund and \$30,000 from the Wildlife Cash Fund.
