After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB26-093 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, line 5, strike "**contractor's license -**
2 **rules -**".

- 3 Page 2, lines 9 and 10, strike "A PERMIT OR LICENSE WITH THE LICENSING
4 AUTHORITY OR" and substitute "A PERMIT WITH THE".

- 5 Page 2, strike line 11 and substitute "GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY.
6 (b) "DECLARATION" MEANS A FORM DESIGNATED BY THE DIVISION
7 AND AVAILABLE ON THE DIVISION'S WEBSITE THAT ENSURES ANY PERSON,
8 INCLUDING ANY SUBCONTRACTORS, WORKING UNDER A PERMIT MAINTAINS
9 WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE IN COMPLIANCE WITH
10 THE REQUIREMENTS OF ARTICLES 40 TO 47 OF THIS TITLE 8 FOR THE
11 DURATION OF THE WORK PERFORMED UNDER THE PERMIT."

- 12 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.

- 13 Page 3, strike lines 2 through 4.

- 14 Reletter succeeding paragraph accordingly.

- 15 Page 3, strike lines 10 through 27 and substitute:
16 "(2) PRIOR TO COMMENCING ANY WORK UNDER A PERMIT, AN
17 APPLICANT SHALL FILE A SIGNED DECLARATION UNDER PENALTY OF
18 PERJURY WITH THE PERMITTING AGENCY ENSURING THAT ANY PERSON,
19 INCLUDING ANY SUBCONTRACTORS, WORKING UNDER THE PERMIT
20 MAINTAINS WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE IN
21 COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF ARTICLES 40 TO 47 OF THIS

1 TITLE 8 FOR THE DURATION OF THE WORK PERFORMED UNDER THE PERMIT.
2 (3) A PERSON MAY FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE DIVISION
3 ALLEGING A PERSON'S WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE
4 IS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF ARTICLES 40 TO 47 OF
5 THIS TITLE 8."
