After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB20-090 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 16, strike "(1)" and substitute "(1); and
2 **add (3.5)**".

3 Page 2, line 19, after "CORRECTIONAL FACILITY," insert "SCHOOL
4 DISTRICT,".

5 Page 3, after line 15 insert:

6 "(IV) "SCHOOL DISTRICT" HAS THE MEANING SET FORTH IN
7 SECTION 22-30-103 (13).

8 (3.5) A FARMER WHO ALLOWS ONE OR MORE INDIVIDUALS TO
9 MAKE ENTRY ON THE FARMER'S PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF GLEANING
10 PRODUCE FOR DONATION TO A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION FOR USE OR
11 DISTRIBUTION IN PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO NEEDY OR POOR PERSONS, AS
12 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1)(a) OF THIS SECTION, IS NOT LIABLE FOR
13 DAMAGES IN ANY CIVIL ACTION OR SUBJECT TO PROSECUTION IN ANY
14 CRIMINAL PROCEEDING RESULTING FROM AN INJURY TO ANY SUCH
15 INDIVIDUALS UNLESS THE INJURY RESULTS FROM A WILLFUL OR WANTON
16 ACT OR OMISSION OF THE FARMER.

17 **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add 22-32-148** as
18 follows:

19 **22-32-148. Food donations to nonprofit organizations**
20 **encouraged.** EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT IS ENCOURAGED TO DONATE

- 1 APPARENTLY WHOLESOME FOOD TO ONE OR MORE LOCAL NONPROFIT
- 2 ORGANIZATIONS FOR DISTRIBUTION TO NEEDY OR POOR INDIVIDUALS."

- 3 Renumber succeeding bill section accordingly.
