Fiscal Summary of Initiative 134

This fiscal summary, prepared by the nonpartisan Director of Research of the Legislative Council, contains a preliminary assessment of the measure's fiscal impact. A full fiscal impact statement for this initiative is or will be available at leg.colorado.gov/bluebook. This fiscal summary identifies the following impact.

State Expenditures

The measure increases state expenditures in the Department of State (DOS) to modify the Statewide Voter Registration System (SCORE) to enable persons currently incarcerated for a felony and people 16 and 17 years of age to participate in elections as allowed by federal law, and to conduct an outreach campaign to inform the public of these changes. Additionally, state expenditures will increase for DOS to reimburse local governments for a portion of their increased election costs related to additional mail ballots and facilitating voting in prisons.

Economic Impacts

The measure has no direct or immediate impact on the state's economy.
