Fiscal Summary of Initiative 295

State Expenditures and Revenue

The measure could change state expenditures and revenue depending on which United States laws, court rulings, regulations, presidential proclamations, and executive orders Colorado chooses to replace with state laws or regulations. The measure would likely result in significant legal expenses related to challenges to the legality of nullifying federal laws, regulations, and court rulings within the state.

Economic Impacts

The measure's impact on the state economy will depend on which state regulations and laws replace any nullified federal regulation and laws.
