Fiscal Summary of Initiative 292

This fiscal summary, prepared by the nonpartisan Director of Research of the Legislative Council, contains a preliminary assessment of the measure's fiscal impact. State Expenditures

The measure may increase state expenditures to appoint ambassadors and have Colorado represented at certain international functions. Because the U.S. Constitution prohibits states from entering treaties or entering agreements or compacts with foreign powers without congressional consent, the measure may also increase legal expenses to contest any action taken against the state.

Economic Impacts

The measure has no direct impact on the state's economy.
