

# An Act

SENATE BILL 18-195

CONCERNING A REQUIREMENT THAT THE MONEY IN THE HEALTHCARE AFFORDABILITY AND SUSTAINABILITY FEE CASH FUND BE APPROPRIATED ANNUALLY RATHER THAN CONTINUOUSLY APPROPRIATED.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*


**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25.5-4-402.4, **amend** (5)(b) introductory portion as follows:

**25.5-4-402.4. Hospitals - healthcare affordability and sustainability fee - legislative declaration - Colorado healthcare affordability and sustainability enterprise - federal waiver - fund created - rules. (5) Healthcare affordability and sustainability fee cash fund.** (b) All money in the fund is subject to federal matching as authorized under federal law ~~and is continuously appropriated to~~ AND, SUBJECT TO ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, SHALL BE EXPENDED BY the enterprise for the following purposes:

*Capital letters or bold & italic numbers indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.*

**SECTION 2. Effective date.** This act takes effect July 1, 2018.

**SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.


