CONCERNING A CHANGE TO HOUSE RULE 35 TO PROHIBIT A MEMBER FROM GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MOVE TO RECONSIDER DURING THE LAST THREE DAYS OF A LEGISLATIVE SESSION.

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-first General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

That in the Rules of the House of Representatives, amend Rule No. 35 (a) as follows:

35. Reconsideration

(a) After a question has been decided by the House, any member recorded as having voted on the prevailing side may, at any time before adjournment of the current legislative day, move to reconsider or may give notice of intention to move to reconsider. Notice having been given, such member may move to reconsider on the same day or before 12 o'clock noon of the next day of actual session, but after the adoption of a resolution fixing the time for adjournment sine die, any member may so move. A MEMBER MAY NOT GIVE NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MOVE TO RECONSIDER IN THE LAST THREE DAYS OF THE SESSION.
