After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB18-132 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike line 6 and substitute:

2 "(1) (a) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL CONDUCT AN ACTUARIAL ANALYSIS  
3 TO DETERMINE IF THE SALE OF CATASTROPHIC HEALTH PLANS TO PERSONS  
4 THIRTY YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER WHO DO NOT MEET A HARDSHIP  
5 REQUIREMENT WOULD RESULT IN A REDUCTION IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF  
6 ADVANCED PREMIUM TAX CREDITS RECEIVED BY COLORADO RESIDENTS  
7 OR WOULD INCREASE THE AVERAGE PREMIUMS OF INDIVIDUAL HEALTH  
8 PLANS IN COLORADO. IF THE ACTUARIAL ANALYSIS DEMONSTRATES THAT  
9 THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF ADVANCED PREMIUM TAX CREDITS RECEIVED BY  
10 COLORADO RESIDENTS WILL NOT DECLINE AND THE AVERAGE PREMIUMS  
11 OF INDIVIDUAL HEALTH PLANS IN COLORADO WILL NOT INCREASE, THEN  
12 THE COMMISSIONER SHALL APPLY TO THE SECRETARY FOR A".

13 Page 3, strike line 13 and substitute "THAT:

14 (I) OFFERING CATASTROPHIC HEALTH PLANS TO INDIVIDUALS  
15 THIRTY".

16 Page 3, strike line 16 and substitute "REQUEST;

17 (II) HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE  
18 WAIVER MAY ONLY BE OFFERED AND SOLD THROUGH THE HEALTH BENEFIT  
19 EXCHANGE; AND

20 (III) HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE  
21 WAIVER ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ADVANCED PREMIUM TAX CREDITS.".

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
