After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB19-1207 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 4, after line 22 insert:

2 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 43-2-145, add (10)  
3 as follows:

4 **43-2-145. Transportation legislation review - committee -**  
5 **definition - repeal.** (10) (a) IN THE 2019 INTERIM BETWEEN THE FIRST  
6 REGULAR SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE  
7 SECOND REGULAR SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY,  
8 THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE COLORADO STATE  
9 PATROL, IN COORDINATION WITH THE COMMITTEE, SHALL MEET WITH  
10 STAKEHOLDERS TO DISCUSS OPTIONS AND METHODS OF TRACTION  
11 CONTROL ENFORCEMENT, INCLUDING THE LEGALITY AND FEASIBILITY OF  
12 PHYSICAL INSPECTION CHECKPOINTS, ON PASSENGER VEHICLES OPERATING  
13 ON INTERSTATE 70 BETWEEN MILEPOST 133 (DOTSERO) AND MILEPOST 259  
14 (MORRISON). IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS PROCESS, THE DEPARTMENT OF  
15 TRANSPORTATION AND THE COLORADO STATE PATROL SHALL DETERMINE  
16 WHETHER THE BEST SOLUTION IS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
17 TRANSPORTATION TO PROPOSE RULES OR TO RECOMMEND LEGISLATION TO  
18 THE COMMITTEE. BY SEPTEMBER 1, 2019, THE DEPARTMENT OF  
19 TRANSPORTATION AND THE COLORADO STATE PATROL SHALL REPORT  
20 THEIR RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE COMMITTEE.

21 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (10) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020."
