After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB19-1237 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Finance with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 8, line 15, strike "SERVICES;" and substitute
- 2 "SERVICES THAT IS NOT A COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER;".

- 3 Page 8, line 17, strike "SERVICES;" and substitute "SERVICES THAT IS NOT
- 4 A COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER;".

- 5 Page 8, after line 21, insert:
- 6 "(G) ONE MEMBER THAT REPRESENTS A SUBSTANCE USE
- 7 TREATMENT PROVIDER FROM A RURAL OR FRONTIER COUNTY;
- 8 (H) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A CONSUMER WHO HAS EXPERIENCE
- 9 LIVING WITH A SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER;".

- 10 Reletter succeeding sub-subparagraphs accordingly.

- 11 Page 32, strike lines 25 through 27 and substitute:
- 12 "**SECTION 25. Act subject to petition - effective date.** Except
- 13 as provided in subsection (2) of this section, this act takes effect at 12:01
- 14 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after
- 15 final adjournment of the general assembly (August 2, 2019, if
- 16 adjournment sine die is on May 3, 2019); except that, if a referendum
- 17 petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state
- 18 constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within
- 19 such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless
- 20 approved by the people at the general election to be held in November
- 21 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official

- 1 declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
- 2 (2) Sections 5 through 8 of this act take effect July 1, 2021, and
- 3 sections 9 through 24 of this act take effect July 1, 2022."
