14 **"SECTION 17. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2019-20 state fiscal  
15 year, \$181,751 is appropriated to the department of health care policy and  
16 financing. Of this appropriation \$123,590 is from the general fund and  
17 \$58,161 is from the healthcare affordability and sustainability fee cash  
18 fund created in section 25.5-4-402.4 (5)(a), C.R.S. To implement this act,  
19 the department may use this appropriation as follows:

20 (a) \$84,771, which consists of \$57,644 from the general fund and  
21 \$27,127 from the healthcare affordability and sustainability fee cash fund,  
22 for use by the executive director's office for personal services, which  
23 amount is based on an assumption that the department will require an  
24 additional 3.0 FTE;

25 (b) \$8,480, which consists of \$5,766 from the general fund and  
26 \$2,714 from the healthcare affordability and sustainability fee cash fund,  
27 for use by the executive director's office for operating expenses; and

28 (c) \$88,500, which consists of \$60,180 from the general fund and  
29 \$28,320 from the healthcare affordability and sustainability fee cash fund,  
30 for use by the executive director's office for general professional services  
31 and special projects.

32 (2) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, the general assembly  
33 anticipates that the department of health care policy and financing will  
34 receive \$181,750 in federal funds to implement this act, which amount  
35 is included for informational purposes only. The appropriation in

1 subsection (1) of this section is based on the assumption that the  
2 department will receive this amount of federal funds to be used as  
3 follows:

4 (a) \$84,771 for use by the executive director's office for personal  
5 services;

6 (b) \$8,479 for use by the executive director's office for operating  
7 expenses; and

8 (c) \$88,500 for use by the executive director's office for general  
9 professional services and special projects.

10 (3) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$88,248 is appropriated to  
11 the department of regulatory agencies for use by the division of insurance.  
12 This appropriation is from the division of insurance cash fund created in  
13 section 10-1-103 (3), C.R.S. To implement this act, the division may use  
14 this appropriation as follows:

15 (a) \$82,500 for personal services, which amount is based on an  
16 assumption that the division will require an additional 1.1 FTE; and

17 (b) \$5,748 for operating expenses."
