Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB19-227 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

1 Amend printed bill, page 18, after line 7 insert:

2           **"SECTION 16. Appropriation.** For the 2019-20 state fiscal year,  
3 \$659,472 is appropriated to the department of public health and  
4 environment. This appropriation consists of \$434,472 from the general  
5 fund and \$225,000 from the opiate antagonist bulk purchase fund created  
6 in section 25-1.5-114 (1)(a), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department  
7 may use this appropriation as follows:

8           (a) \$621,070 which consists of \$396,070 from general fund and  
9 \$225,000 from the opiate antagonist bulk purchase fund, for use by the  
10 prevention services division for administration, which amount is based on  
11 an assumption that the department will require an additional 1.8 FTE; and

12           (b) \$38,402 from general fund for the household take-back  
13 medication program, which amount is based on an assumption that the  
14 department will require an additional 0.4 FTE."

15 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

16 Page 2 of the Health & Human Services Committee Report, dated April  
17 11, 2019, line 17, strike ""AND".

18 Page 2 of the Committee Report, strike line 20 and substitute "**DISORDER,**  
19 **AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**".
