Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB19-235 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the State, Veterans, and Military Affairs Committee Report, dated
2 April 10, 2019, page 2, after line 22 insert:

3 "Page 17, after line 24 insert:

4 **"SECTION 12. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2019-20 state fiscal
5 year, \$67,840 is appropriated to the department of state for use by the
6 information technology division. This appropriation is from the
7 department of state cash fund created in section 24-21-104 (3)(b), C.R.S.
8 To implement this act, the division may use this appropriation for
9 personal services.

10 (2) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$90,827 is appropriated to
11 the department of human services for use by the office of information
12 technology services. This appropriation consists of \$61,301 from the
13 general fund, \$9,973 from the old age pension fund created in section 1
14 of article XXIV of the state constitution, and \$19,553 from the federal
15 temporary assistance for needy families block grant. To implement this
16 act, the office may use this appropriation for operating and contract
17 expenses.

18 (3) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, the general assembly
19 anticipates that the department of human services will receive \$45,413 in
20 federal funds for the office of information technology services to
21 implement this act. The appropriation in subsection (2) of this section is
22 based on the assumption that the department will receive this amount of

1 federal funds.

2 (4) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$136,240 is appropriated to
3 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.
4 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the
5 department of human services under subsections (2) and (3) of this
6 section. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation to
7 provide information technology services for the department of human
8 services.

9 (4) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$18,000 is appropriated to
10 the department of revenue for use by the division of motor vehicles. This
11 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the division
12 may use this appropriation for DRIVES maintenance and support."

13 Renumber succeeding section accordingly."

14 Page 1 of the bill, line 102, strike "VOTERS." and substitute "VOTERS,
15 AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
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
