2 "(b) THE BOARD MAY, WITHIN EXISTING FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR
3 OPERATION OF THE PROGRAM, PROVIDE A MEANS OF".

4 Page 13 of the bill, strike lines 26 and 27.

5 Strike page 14 of the bill.

6 Page 15 of the bill, strike lines 1 through 15.

7 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

8 Page 15 of the bill, line 20, strike "(I)".

9 Page 16 of the bill, strike lines 4 through 8.

10 Page 16 of the bill, strike lines 9 through 27.

11 Strike pages 17 and 18 of the bill and substitute:

12 **SECTION 20. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2020-21 state fiscal
13 year, \$18,540 is appropriated to the department of regulatory agencies.
14 This appropriation is from the division of professions and occupations
15 cash fund created in section 12-20-105 (3), C.R.S. To implement this act,
16 the department may use this appropriation as follows:

17 (a) \$2,550 for the colorado medical board; and

18 (b) \$15,990 for the purchase of legal services.

19 (2) For the 2020-21 state fiscal year, \$15,990 is appropriated to
20 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
21 received from the department of regulatory agencies under subsection
22 (1)(b) of this section. To implement this act, the department of law may
23 use this appropriation to provide legal services for the department of
24 regulatory agencies.

25 **SECTION 21. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
26 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
27 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
28 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
29 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
30 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
31 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in

1 November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
2 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."

3 Page 1 of the printed bill, line 101, strike "**DISORDERS.**" and substitute
4 "**DISORDERS, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN**
5 **APPROPRIATION.**".
