Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB20-1160 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 30, after line 8 insert:

2 **"SECTION 7. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2020-21 state fiscal
3 year, \$273,119 is appropriated to the department of regulatory agencies.
4 This appropriation is from the division of insurance cash fund created in
5 section 10-1-103 (3), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may
6 use this appropriation as follows:

7 (a) \$189,288 for use by the division of insurance for personal
8 services, which amount is based on an assumption that the division will
9 require an additional 2.5 FTE;

10 (b) \$21,975 for use by the division of insurance for operating
11 expenses;

12 (c) \$17,056 for the purchase of legal services; and

13 (d) \$44,800 for the purchase of information technology services.

14 (2) For the 2020-21 state fiscal year, \$17,056 is appropriated to
15 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
16 received from the department of regulatory agencies under subsection
17 (1)(c) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department
18 of law will require an additional 0.1 FTE. To implement this act, the
19 department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for
20 the department of regulatory agencies.

21 (3) For the 2020-21 state fiscal year, \$44,800 is appropriated to
22 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.

23 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the

1 department of regulatory agencies under subsection (1)(d) of this section.
2 To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation to provide
3 information technology services for the department of regulatory
4 agencies."

5 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

6 Page 1, line 112, strike "AND".

7 Page 2, line 101, strike "DRUGS." and substitute "DRUGS; AND MAKING
8 AN APPROPRIATION."
