Committee on Finance.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB20-1190 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 21, after the period add "THE VETERAN  
2 WHO IS APPLYING FOR THE EXEMPTION IN THIS SUBSECTION (5) FOR A  
3 MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS ALREADY REGISTERED DOES NOT RECEIVE ANY  
4 CREDIT OR REFUND FOR ANY TAXES AND FEES PREVIOUSLY PAID ON THE  
5 MOTOR VEHICLE."

6 Page 3, line 20, after the period add "THE VETERAN WHO IS APPLYING FOR  
7 THE EXEMPTION IN THIS SUBSECTION (3)(a) FOR A VEHICLE THAT IS  
8 ALREADY REGISTERED DOES NOT RECEIVE ANY CREDIT OR REFUND FOR  
9 ANY TAXES AND FEES PREVIOUSLY PAID ON THE VEHICLE."

10 Page 3, strike lines 21 through 27 and substitute:

11 **"SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date -**  
12 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect January 1, 2021; except that, if a  
13 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the  
14 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act  
15 within the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general  
16 assembly, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless  
17 approved by the people at the general election to be held in November  
18 2020 and, in such case, will take effect January 1, 2021, or on the date of  
19 the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor, whichever is  
20 later.

1           (2) This act applies to registrations completed or renewed on or  
2 after the applicable effective date of this act."
