3 **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-250-104, **amend**  
4 (1)(b)(II) and (2) as follows:

5 **12-250-104. Naturopathic medicine advisory committee -**  
6 **creation - membership - duties.** (1)(b) The advisory committee consists  
7 of nine members appointed by the director as follows:

8 (II) Three members who are doctors of medicine or osteopathy  
9 licensed pursuant to article 240 of this title 12, ONE OF WHOM IS A  
10 PEDIATRICIAN AND ANOTHER OF WHOM IS A MEMBER OF A STATEWIDE  
11 MULTISPECIALTY MEDICAL SOCIETY;

12 (2) The advisory committee shall MEET AT LEAST ONCE EACH  
13 YEAR TO:

14 (a) Advise the director in the administration and enforcement of  
15 this article 250 and rules adopted under this article 250;

16 (b) DISCUSS ISSUES OF IMPORTANCE TO NATUROPATHIC DOCTORS  
17 AND THEIR PATIENTS; AND

18 (c) (I) REVIEW THE NATUROPATHIC FORMULARY SPECIFIED IN  
19 SECTION 12-250-106 (1)(c)(I); AND

20 (II) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE DIRECTOR ON WHETHER  
21 THERE SHOULD BE ADDITIONS, OTHER THAN CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES, TO  
22 THE NATUROPATHIC FORMULARY. POSSIBLE ADDITIONS MAY INCLUDE  
23 ONLY BIOLOGICAL SUBSTANCES INCLUDING VITAMINS, MINERALS,  
24 NUTRITIVE SUBSTANCES, EXTRACTS, AND THEIR PRODUCTS AND RESIDUES.

25 **SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-250-106, **amend**  
26 (1)(c)(I) and (5)(c) as follows:

27 **12-250-106. Practice of naturopathic medicine by**  
28 **naturopathic doctors - exclusions - protected activities - definition -**  
29 **rules.** (1) The practice of naturopathic medicine by a naturopathic doctor  
30 includes the following:

31 (c) (I) Obtaining, dispensing, administering, ordering, or  
32 prescribing, as specified, medicines listed in the naturopathic formulary,  
33 which includes:

34 (A) ~~Obtaining, administering, or dispensing~~ Epinephrine to treat  
35 anaphylaxis;

36 (B) ~~Obtaining and dispensing~~ Barrier contraceptives, excluding  
37 intrauterine devices;

38 (C) ~~Obtaining and administering~~ Oxygen, but only for emergency  
39 use;

40 (D) ~~Obtaining and administering~~ Vitamins B6 and B12;

41 (E) ~~Obtaining, administering, or dispensing~~ Substances that are

1 regulated by the federal food and drug administration but that do not  
2 require a prescription order to be dispensed; and

3 (F) ~~Obtaining and administering~~ Vaccines, in accordance with the  
4 ACIP guidelines, for patients who are at least eighteen years of age; AND

5 (G) ANY ADDITIONS TO THE NATUROPATHIC FORMULARY AS  
6 DETERMINED BY THE DIRECTOR BY RULE, LIMITED TO BIOLOGICAL  
7 SUBSTANCES INCLUDING VITAMINS, MINERALS, NUTRITIVE SUBSTANCES,  
8 EXTRACTS, AND THEIR PRODUCTS AND RESIDUES.

9 (5) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section, a person  
10 who is not registered under this article 250 shall not:

11 (c) Use the title "naturopathic doctor", ~~or~~ "doctor of naturopathy",  
12 ~~or~~ the abbreviation "N.D.", OR ANY OTHER TITLE THAT IMPLIES THE  
13 PERSON IS REGISTERED OR LICENSED AS A NATUROPATHIC DOCTOR.

14 **SECTION 6. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act  
15 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the  
16 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August  
17 5, 2020, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2020); except that, if a  
18 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the  
19 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act  
20 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect  
21 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in  
22 November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the  
23 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."
