Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB21-021 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

1 Amend printed bill, page 39, after line 16 insert:

2 **"SECTION 4. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2021-22 state fiscal
3 year, \$108,432 is appropriated to the department of regulatory agencies.
4 This appropriation is from the division of professions and occupations
5 cash fund created in section 12-20-105 (3), C.R.S. To implement this act,
6 the division may use this appropriation as follows:

7 (a) \$14,418 for use by the division of professions and occupations
8 for personal services, which amount is based on an assumption that the
9 department will require an additional 0.3 FTE;

10 (b) \$17,000 for use by the division of professions and occupations
11 for operating expenses;

12 (c) \$17,014 for the purchase of legal services; and

13 (d) \$60,000 for the purchase of information technology services.

14 (2) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$17,014 is appropriated to
15 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
16 received from the department of regulatory agencies under subsection
17 (1)(c) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department
18 of law will require an additional 0.1 FTE. To implement this act, the
19 department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for
20 the department of regulatory agencies.

21 (3) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$60,000 is appropriated to
22 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.

1 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the
2 department of regulatory agencies under subsection (1)(d) of this section.
3 To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation to provide
4 information technology services for the department of regulatory
5 agencies.

6 (4) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$21,503 is appropriated to the
7 department of public safety for use by the Colorado bureau of
8 investigation. This appropriation is from the Colorado bureau of
9 investigation identification unit cash fund created in section 24-33.5-426,
10 C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation
11 as follows:

12 (a) \$6,251 for use by the biometric identification and records unit
13 for personal services, which amount is based on an assumption that the
14 unit will require an additional 0.1 FTE;

15 (b) \$15,252 for use by the biometric identification and records
16 unit for operating expenses."

17 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

18 Page 1, line 102, strike "**COMPACT**". and substitute "**COMPACT**", **AND,**
19 **IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**".
