Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB21-138 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

- 1 Amend the Judiciary Committee Report, dated March 24, 2021, page 1,
- 2 strike lines 2 through 5, and substitute:
  - 3 "Page 4, line 7, strike "(1) and (2);" and substitute "(1);".
  - 4 Page 4, strike lines 19 through 27.
  - 5 Page 5, strike lines 1 through 14.
  - 6 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly."
  - 7 Amend printed bill, page 5, line 18, strike "MAY" and substitute "SHALL".
  - 8 Page 5 of the printed bill, line 23, after "SYSTEM." insert "AS A PART OF
  - 9 THE PILOT PROGRAM, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE A SCREENING
  - 10 EVALUATION FOR A BRAIN INJURY FOR ALL OFFENDERS AT ONE
  - 11 CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION."
  - 12 Page 8 of the printed bill, after line 27 insert:
    - 13 **"SECTION 6. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2021-22 state fiscal
    - 14 year, \$143,265 is appropriated to the department of corrections for use by
    - 15 institutions. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement

1 this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:  
2 (a) \$61,715 for personal services related to the mental health  
3 subprogram, which amount is based on an assumption that the department  
4 will require an additional 0.9 FTE;  
5 (b) \$11,550 for operating expenses related to the mental health  
6 subprogram; and  
7 (c) \$70,000 for medical contract services related to the mental  
8 health subprogram."

9 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

10 Page 1 of the printed bill, line 102, strike "INJURY." and substitute  
11 "INJURY, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN  
12 APPROPRIATION."

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
