After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB22-1229 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, line 23, strike "24-4.2-104 (1)(b)(I)," and
2 substitute "24-4.2-104 (1)(b)(III)."

3 Page 6, line 22, strike "16-2.3-105 (5)(a)(I)" and substitute "16-2.3-106
4 (5)(a)(I)".

5 Page 18, after line 19 insert:

6 "SECTION 15. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 17-26-109, amend
7 (1)(b)(I) as follows:

8 "17-26-109. Deductions of time - record keeping - forfeitures -
9 definition - repeal. (1) Every person who is sentenced to and imprisoned
10 in any county jail of this state who performs faithfully the duties assigned
11 to him or her and conducts himself or herself in accordance with the rules
12 of the jail earns deductions from the time of his or her sentence as
13 follows:

14 (b) In addition to the deduction described in subsection (1)(a) of
15 this section, an inmate may receive a three-day deduction for each thirty
16 days on his or her sentence if he or she:

17 (I) SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETES A DESIGNATED PROGRAM OR
18 EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITY WITHIN THE JAIL OR is designated by the county
19 sheriff as a trusty prisoner;"

20 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
