Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB22-1304 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 23, after line 10 insert:

2           **"SECTION 7. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal  
3 year, \$431,985 is appropriated to the office of the governor. This  
4 appropriation consists of \$319,450 from reappropriated funds received  
5 from the department of local affairs from the local investments in  
6 transformational affordable housing fund created in section 24-32-726  
7 (4)(a), C.R.S., that originate from money the state received from the  
8 federal coronavirus state fiscal recovery fund and \$112,535 from  
9 reappropriated funds received from the department of local affairs from  
10 the strong communities grant program fund created in section 24-32-132  
11 (5), C.R.S. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation  
12 as follows:

13           (a) \$379,081, which consists of \$319,450 from reappropriated  
14 funds received from the department of local affairs from the local  
15 investments in transformational affordable housing fund created in  
16 section 24-32-726 (4)(a), C.R.S., that originate from money the state  
17 received from the federal coronavirus state fiscal recovery fund and  
18 \$59,631 from reappropriated funds received from the department of local  
19 affairs from the strong communities grant program fund created in section  
20 24-32-132 (5), C.R.S., for use by the office of information technology to  
21 provide information technology services for the department of local  
22 affairs; and

23           (b) \$52,904 from reappropriated funds received from the  
24 department of local affairs from the strong communities grant program  
25 fund created in section 24-32-132 (5), C.R.S., for use by the Colorado  
26 energy office for program administration, which amount is based on an  
27 assumption that the office will require an addition 0.5 FTE to implement

1 this act."

2 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

3 Page 1, line 107, strike "HOUSING." and substitute "HOUSING, AND  
4 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."

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
