After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB22-1383 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike lines 14 through 19 and substitute
- 2 "juvenile justice system. The act does not limit the current application of
- 3 section 19-1-304 (1)(b.5) or (5), Colorado Revised Statutes, as those
- 4 provisions relate to specific information for certain offenses, including
- 5 unlawful sexual behavior, crimes of violence, possession of a handgun,
- 6 class 1, 2, 3, or 4 felonies, and crimes involving the use or possession of
- 7 a weapon."

- 8 Page 4, strike lines 2 through 4 and substitute "- **repeal.** (4) (a) FOR THE
- 9 2022-23 STATE FISCAL YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT MAY SPEND MONEY
- 10 APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FROM
- 11 THE GENERAL FUND IN HOUSE BILL 22-1329 TO EXPAND THE".

- 12 Page 4, line 7, strike "(A)" and substitute "(I)".

- 13 Page 4, line 11, strike "(B)" and substitute "(II)".

- 14 Page 4, line 13, strike "(C)" and substitute "(III)".

- 15 Page 4, line 16, strike "(D)" and substitute "(IV)".

- 16 Page 4, strike lines 18 through 22.

- 17 Page 5, strike line 14 and substitute "EMPLOYMENT, AN".

- 18 Page 5, strike lines 20 through 27 and substitute:

- 19 "(c) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (2)(b) OF THIS SECTION,

1 NOTHING IN THIS SECTION LIMITS PUBLIC ACCESS TO INFORMATION AS SET
2 FORTH IN SECTION 19-1-304 (1)(b.5) OR (5)."

3 Page 6, strike lines 1 through 7.

4 Page 6, line 10, strike "SECTION 27-90-111." and substitute "SECTION
5 27-90-111 OR THE SCREENING OF APPLICANTS REQUIRED BY LICENSED
6 CHILD CARE CENTERS PURSUANT TO SECTION 26-6-905 OR 26.5-5-309."
