Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB22-173 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, before line 10 insert:

2           **"SECTION 3. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal  
3 year, \$505,819 is appropriated to the department of regulatory agencies.  
4 This appropriation is from the division of professions and occupations  
5 cash fund created in section 12-20-105 (3), C.R.S. To implement this act,  
6 the department may use this appropriation as follows:

7           (a) \$383,823 for use by the division of professions and  
8 occupations for personal services, which amount is based on an  
9 assumption that the division will require an additional 4.4 FTE;

10           (b) \$43,140 for use by the division of professions and occupations  
11 for operating expenses; and

12           (c) \$78,856 for the purchase of legal services.

13           (2) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$78,856 is appropriated to  
14 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds  
15 received from the department of regulatory agencies under subsection  
16 (1)(c) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department  
17 of law will require an additional 0.4 FTE. To implement this act, the  
18 department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for  
19 the department of regulatory agencies."

20 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

21 Page 1, line 102, strike "OUTLETS." and substitute "OUTLETS, AND, IN  
22 CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
