Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB23-1057 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the State, Civil, Military, and Veterans Affairs Committee Report,  
2 dated February 13, 2023, page 3, line 40, after "A" insert "STATE  
3 DEPARTMENT OR STATE AGENCY,".

4 Page 4, line 1, before "A" insert "THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION OR".

5 Page 4, line 5, strike "PUBLIC".

6 Page 4, lines 5 and 6, strike "THE STATE OR A STATE AGENCY" and  
7 substitute "A PUBLIC ENTITY".

8 Page 5, line 1, strike "THE STATE OR A STATE AGENCY" and substitute "A  
9 PUBLIC ENTITY".

10 Page 5, line 16, strike "ON AND AFTER JULY 1, 2024," and substitute  
11 "BEGINNING JULY 1, 2024, BUT NO LATER THAN JULY 1, 2026, SUBJECT TO  
12 AVAILABLE APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC ENTITIES THAT ARE A STATE  
13 AGENCY,".

14 Page 5, line 17, strike "THE STATE OR A STATE AGENCY," and substitute "A  
15 PUBLIC ENTITY".

16 Page 6, after line 37 insert:

17 **"9-5.7-104. Restroom survey of state-owned buildings -**  
18 **priority of modifications.** (1) (a) THE DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL  
19 SHALL COMPLETE A SURVEY AND PROVIDE IT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY  
20 AND THE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE DETERMINING THE NUMBER

1 AND LOCATIONS OF SIGNS THAT NEED TO BE REPLACED OR MODIFIED  
2 PURSUANT TO SECTION 9-5.7-103 (3) FOR EXISTING RESTROOMS ACROSS  
3 ALL BUILDINGS WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY OWNED BY THE STATE.

4 (b) FOR A BUILDING THAT IS WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY OWNED OR  
5 LEASED BY THE STATE OR A STATE AGENCY, IF SIGNAGE IS NEEDED AT  
6 EITHER THE RESTROOM LOCATION OR THE DIRECTORY, A PUBLIC ENTITY  
7 THAT IS A STATE AGENCY OR A STATE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION  
8 SHALL PROVIDE INFORMATION ON THE NUMBER AND LOCATIONS OF SIGNS  
9 THAT NEED TO BE MODIFIED AND MAY REQUEST STATE FUNDING SUBJECT  
10 TO AVAILABLE APPROPRIATIONS IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH SECTION  
11 9-5.7-103 (3) TO THE STATE ARCHITECT.

12 (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL SHALL PROVIDE AN INTERIM  
13 REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT  
14 COMMITTEE BY JANUARY 1, 2024, AND A FINAL REPORT BY JULY 1, 2024.

15 (3) FOR PURPOSES OF COMPLYING WITH SECTION 9-5.7-103 (3), THE  
16 DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL SHALL PRIORITIZE THE PLACEMENT OF  
17 SIGNAGE IN BUILDINGS OR PORTIONS OF BUILDINGS THAT ARE ACCESSIBLE  
18 TO THE PUBLIC."

19 Page 6, before line 38 insert:

20 **"SECTION 2. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2023-24 state fiscal  
21 year, \$450,000 is appropriated to the department of personnel for use by  
22 the office of the state architect. This appropriation is from the general  
23 fund. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation as  
24 follows:

25 (a) \$400,000 for statewide planning services; and

26 (b) \$50,000 for a restroom survey of state-owned buildings.

27 (2) Any money appropriated under subsection (1)(a) of this  
28 section not expended prior to July 1, 2024, is further appropriated to the  
29 office for the 2024-25 and 2025-26 state fiscal years for the same  
30 purpose."

31 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

32 Page 7, after line 3 insert:

33 "Page 1 of the bill, line 102, strike "GENDERS." and substitute "GENDERS,  
34 AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."."
