<u>HB23-1246</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

Amend the printed bill, page 5, line 14, after "TRANSPORTATION," insert
 "CHILD OR DEPENDENT CARE,".

4 "SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-1-104, amend
5 (1)(b)(I); and add (1)(c.5) as follows:

6 23-1-104. Financing the system of postsecondary education -7 **report.** (1) (b) (I) For the 2010-11 fiscal year and for fiscal years 8 beginning on or after July 1, 2016, the general assembly shall make 9 annual appropriations of general fund money, of cash funds received from 10 tuition income, and of money that is estimated to be received by an 11 institution, under the direction and control of the governing board, as 12 stipends, as defined in section 23-18-102, and through fee-for-service 13 contracts, as authorized in section 23-1-109.7 or 23-18-303.5, whichever 14 is applicable, as a single line item to each governing board for the 15 operation of its campuses; except that, if the general assembly 16 appropriates money, as described in subsection (1)(c) of this section, to 17 the Colorado state forest service, the agricultural experiment station 18 department of the Colorado state university, or the Colorado state 19 university cooperative extension service, OR TO THE STATE BOARD FOR 20 COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND OCCUPATIONAL EDUCATION AS DESCRIBED IN 21 SUBSECTION (1)(c.5) OF THIS SECTION, such money shall not be included 22 within the single line item appropriations described in this subsection 23 (1)(b).24 (c.5) IN ADDITION TO ANY APPROPRIATIONS MADE PURSUANT TO

Annual appropriations - repeal.** (12) (a) THE 7 PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION CONCERNING 8 APPROPRIATIONS FOR STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS 9 ARTICLE 3.3 DO NOT APPLY TO APPROPRIATIONS MADE PURSUANT TO 10 SECTION 23-60-1201 FOR THE IN-DEMAND SHORT-TERM CREDENTIALS 11 PROGRAM.

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(b) This subsection (12) is repealed, effective July 1, 2027.".

21 (e) For fiscal year 2022-23, the general assembly shall appropriate 22 ten million dollars from the economic recovery and relief cash fund 23 created in section 24-75-228 to the department. The department shall use 24 this appropriation for recruitment and re-engagement efforts of workers 25 in the health-care profession with current or expired licenses and staffing. 26 ANY MONEY REMAINING AT THE END OF THE 2022-23 STATE FISCAL YEAR 27 FROM THIS APPROPRIATION IS FURTHER APPROPRIATED TO THE 28 DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION. ANY MONEY THAT IS 29 NOT EXPENDED OR OBLIGATED BY DECEMBER 30, 2024, REVERTS TO THE 30 "AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021" CASH FUND CREATED IN SECTION 31 24-75-226 (2) IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 24-75-226 (4)(d). ANY 32 MONEY OBLIGATED BY DECEMBER 30, 2024, MUST BE EXPENDED BY 33 DECEMBER 31, 2026.

34 SECTION 8. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-1.5-406, amend
35 (9) as follows:

25-1.5-406. School nurse grant program - creation - eligibility
- award of grants - rules - report - legislative declaration - definitions.
(9) The general assembly shall appropriate three million dollars from the
economic recovery and relief cash fund created in section 24-75-228 to
the department for the GRANT program. ANY MONEY REMAINING AT THE

END OF THE 2022-23 STATE FISCAL YEAR FROM THIS APPROPRIATION IS
 FURTHER APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS
 SECTION. ANY MONEY THAT IS NOT EXPENDED OR OBLIGATED BY
 DECEMBER 30, 2024, REVERTS TO THE "AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF
 2021" CASH FUND CREATED IN SECTION 24-75-226 (2) IN ACCORDANCE
 WITH SECTION 24-75-226 (4)(d). ANY MONEY OBLIGATED BY DECEMBER
 30, 2024, MUST BE EXPENDED BY DECEMBER 31, 2026.

8 **SECTION 9. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2023-24 state fiscal 9 year, \$43,600,000 is appropriated to the department of higher education 10 for allocation to the state board for community colleges and occupational 11 education. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this 12 act, the board may use this appropriation as follows:

13 (a) \$38,600,000 for the in-demand short-term credentials program;
14 and

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(b) \$5,000,000 for short-term degree nursing programs.

16 (2) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$1,400,000 is appropriated 17 to the department of labor and employment. This appropriation is from 18 the general fund, and is based on an assumption that the department will 19 require an additional 1.2 FTE. To implement this act, the department may 20 use this appropriation for the construction registered apprenticeship grant 21 program administered by the office of the future of work.".
