Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB23-031 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 12, after line 5 insert:

2 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-3.3-103, add
3 (12) as follows:

4 **23-3.3-103. Annual appropriations - repeal.** (12) THE
5 PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION CONCERNING
6 APPROPRIATIONS FOR STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO THIS
7 ARTICLE 3.3 DO NOT APPLY TO APPROPRIATIONS MADE PURSUANT TO PART
8 11 OF ARTICLE 21 OF THIS TITLE 23 FOR THE COLORADO
9 MULTIDISCIPLINARY HEALTH-CARE PROVIDER ACCESS TRAINING
10 PROGRAM."

11 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

12 Page 12, after line 12 insert:

13 "SECTION 4. **Appropriation.** (1) For the 2023-24 state fiscal
14 year, \$784,269 is appropriated to the department of higher education. This
15 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the
16 department may use this appropriation for the college opportunity fund
17 program to be used for limited purpose fee-for-service contracts with
18 state institutions.

19 (2) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$784,269 is appropriated to
20 the department of higher education. This appropriation is from
21 reappropriated funds received from the limited purpose fee-for-service
22 contracts with state institutions under subsection (1) of this section. To
23 implement this act, the department may use this appropriation for the
24 regents of the university of Colorado."
