CONCERNING AN EXTENSION OF THE TIME FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE  
WILD HORSE POPULATION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 35-1-119, **amend** (2) as follows:

**35-1-119. Wild horse population management - repeal.** (2) This section is repealed, effective ~~July 31, 2024~~ **DECEMBER 31, 2025**.






